Meet the Editors

Greetings. We are Peg and Ken Cizadlo and we have been the editors of Kitty Hawk Square Dance Newsletter for just over a decade now. (Boy, does time fly.) Ken is an analyst at Wright-Patterson AFB and Peg is currently a nursing professional development specialist at Southview Hospital, Maternity Unit.

We have two sons, one in college and one out of college (both engineers). Both have been to Club Picnics, and the younger one attended many dances (only as an observed) when he was too young to be left home by himself. He used to come for the food and play cards with Darrell, Shep, and anyone else that was available, or he would read some books that he would bring with him. Neither son wanted to learn to square dance, their loss.

We really didn't know anything about square dancing in the area until some friends mentioned it. A person that Ken knew from work and whom he used to run with had talked to him about taking square dancing lessons and some mutual friends of Peg and Ken were square dancers with the Kitty Hawks, and they talked it up, also. So, we joined the club where our friends were members. (Unfortunately, because of other obligations, they stopped coming before we finished lessons.) The lesson learned from this is to talk up square dancing, you never know who may be joining the club next.

We participated in the 2002-2003 lesson class and have enjoyed it ever since. We enjoy the friends that we have made, the sites we have seen, the knowledge that square dancing is done nearly everywhere in the US (though the only time we square danced while on vacation was in Oregon), and the exercise that the activity itself gives us. Most of all, square dancing give us a mutual activity that we like to share with each other and others.

We became editors of the newsletter about a half year after we finished lessons. Sam Dunn (Tim and Patty Dunn's brother) had been the editor, but he moved to Florida. In the age of emails, it was workable for him to work as the editor, but he thought it best that it be done by someone in the area. Since both of us are computer savvy, he asked us, and we have been editors ever since.

We have gone to a few Ohio State Conventions and one National Convention (so far). The National Convention was in 2012 in Spokane, Washington. We had arrived early and took in a three-day tour prior to the start of the convention. We also did some sight-seeing during the conventions. One of the things that we really enjoy about conventions (both state and national) is the ability to try different types of dancing (introductory level). We have done some Hex Squares, Contras, Country Western Partner, Round, and Line dances. We highly recommend looking to see what is available and trying a few things out.
