Kitty Hawk History

It all started in Rex Parham's barber shop. Emery Wheat and Rex were tired of driving to Cincinnati to square dance at a singles club. The club in Middletown was disbanding so, with encouragement from their friends and using their own money, the fellows decided to "get something going in Dayton". This was the Fall of 1977.

There were not enough experienced dancers to start a club, so they needed to have a lesson class. Emery began to talk the idea up and finally came up with four men and four women (experienced dancers) who were willing to work toward a singles club. Dorothy Hollingsworth put two ads in the Fairborn paper for two weeks. Rex Parham had printed 500 flyers advertising the lessons. Emery had 200 handbills printed and he also placed advertisements in the Kettering and Centerville Times, Miamisburg and West Carrollton papers.

There were many meetings held at Rex's barber shop and in his home. The weather was bad that Fall, and lesson classes were delayed. The lesson class was started the first Wednesday in February 1978. Caller Jack Watts taught the first ten weeks of lessons at St. George Episcopal Church on Far Hills Avenue. A caller from Middletown taught the class for 3 or 4 weeks. Then Ed Raney from Cincinnati became the regular club caller. The last 3 lesson classes were held at the Church of the Cross United Methodist Church on Wilmington Pike at Devon. During this

period Emery became ill and Rex kept the lesson class going.

The first class graduated in June 1978. At graduation, a club was formed and plans were made for a dance. The Civilian Club at WPAFB was rented. A meeting was held on June 12, 1978, at Perkins Pancake House on Dorothy Lane to organize the club. Those present voted and the name Kittyhawk was chosen. It was decided that married couples would be included for membership. Charter members of the club (attending that meeting) were: Dorothy Hollingsworth, Emery Wheat, Frank Klipple, Rex Parham, Larry Estes, Mary Miller, Dale Dunford, Gladys Sherman, Jane Burrows, Fern Ochs, Dorothy Fraser and Vic Carpenter. (There may also have been others that have been forgotten at the time this article was written in 1989.) Officers were elected: Larry Estes, President and Rex Parham, Vice-President.

The first dance for the new club was held July 12, 1978, at the Civilian Club at WPAFB. Ed Raney was the caller. The dance was open to singles and couples. After 18 months dancing at the Civilian Club, the club was moved to another building on the Base.

On August 6, 1980 the Kittyhawks moved activities to Belmont United Methodist Church on Smithville Road. The Club splintered and formed Twin Base Squares in Fairborn.

March 20, 1981, the Kittyhawks moved to Good Shepherd Lutheran Church, Kettering. Ed Raney was replaced by Sam Dunn as the club caller. Jason Raleigh took over for Sam for a few years. The club has since decided to go without a club caller. The club has moved a few more times since then but are now back to dance at Good Shepherd.
