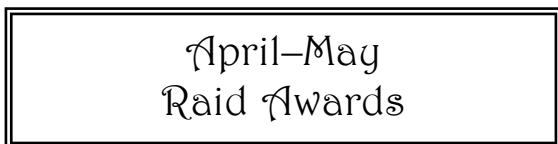
From the Raid
